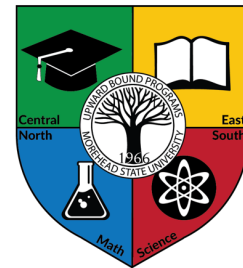

Dear Parents of Upward Bound & Upward Bound Math & Science Bridge Students:

The beginning of the Upward Bound Summer Program is rapidly approaching. We are excited to have your student on campus with us this summer! Currently, females are scheduled to reside in West Mignon and males in Alumni Tower. If this should change, we will let you know.

This year, Bridge students will Move-In on Wednesday, June 7, 2020 and move-out on Friday, July, 3rd. We will send out move in times and bus schedules for the Summer Academy at the end of April. In order for your student to attend we need you to complete and return to us several forms. Included in this packet are:

All forms included in this mailing should be returned to our office by **April 9, by 4:00 pm**. Unfortunately, any late submissions cannot be accepted because we are required to have our numbers in to the University by April 10th. If you misplace these forms, we can send you additional copies, or you can download them from our website: www.moreheadub.org/summer-forms.

Please note: The MSU Student Medical History Form requires immunization information. **Please provide Upward Bound a copy of this immunization record with your completed forms.** You may obtain a copy of your son/daughter's immunization record from your county health department; some high schools may also maintain this information. **We do not keep immunization records that you may have previously submitted to Upward Bound**, and therefore you will have to submit these each year. Several forms have information on the front and back side of the paper; be sure to complete both sides and to **SIGN ALL FORMS WHERE INDICATED.**

Because the students come home every weekend, we do not allow students to have visitors on campus, or to leave campus with visitors. However, we also know that there may be times that a parent/legal guardian, or someone authorized by a parent/legal guardian, may need to pick up a student to provide transportation home on Friday afternoons. **Students are not allowed to leave campus with anyone (other than parents/legal guardians) at any other time.**

Please note: Bridge students are not allowed to miss any class days during the Summer Academy.

If your son/daughter will not be able to attend Upward Bound this summer, please complete the form at the beginning of this packet.

At the end of April we will send out a packet with check-in times and locations.

Thank you for agreeing to share your son or daughter with us this summer. If you have any questions before the students arrive on campus for the summer, or anytime while they are with us, please feel free to call me, or any of the Upward Bound staff.
